Research papers covering all aspects of finance and financial education are invited for consideration in the program. We also invite posters and proposals for panel discussions and tutorials. Academicians, practitioners, and others with an interest in finance are invited to attend and participate in the meeting.

Submission. Please submit research papers and proposals using the following link:

- There is a submission fee per paper/proposal submitted of \$35 for regular members and \$25 for doctoral students.
- Research papers should be in PDF format. Completed papers are encouraged and will receive preference over proposals.
- Research proposals must include a clear description of the primary issues, a review of the literature, and description of the data and methodology. Research proposals should be in PDF format and not exceed six pages in length.
- Panel, tutorial, or workshop proposals may be submitted to the Program Chair. Special session submissions must also complete the participation form on the SWFA website.
- Papers may also be accepted to poster sessions.

Registration. All presenters, discussants, session chairs, and panel members must be registered with FBD and with SWFA.

Membership. Active Southwestern Finance Association membership is required for any paper, proposal or workshop submissions. The link to the association membership page is

In recent meetings, over 80 Ph.D. students from 20 countries presented their papers at the conference, attended special sessions designed for doctoral students, and networked with colleagues from all over the world.
