We invite and encourage academicians, practitioners, members of the SSE, graduate and undergraduate students to be involved in some capacity by:

- **Presenting a Paper, Abstract, or Research Proposal:** Share your work on topics relevant to both academicians and practitioners.
- Organizing an Invited Paper Session, Panel, or Tutorial: Lead discussions and share expertise in a structured format.
- Serving as a Session Chair or Paper Discussant: Facilitate and contribute to discussions on presented works.
- **Participating in Poster Sessions:** Submit a 2-page abstract and a draft of your final poster. This is an excellent opportunity for undergraduate, master's, and doctoral students.

Also, consider:

- Submitting a Paper for the 2026 McGraw-Hill/Irwin Distinguished Paper Award: This award recognizes outstanding research papers.
- Encouraging Graduate and Undergraduate Student Submissions: Awards will be given for the best graduate and undergraduate papers.
- Nominating a Candidate for the 2026 FBD Outstanding Educator Award: Highlight and celebrate excellence in education.
