Call for Papers

AARE invites academicians, scholars, practitioners, and students (graduate and nongraduate) to submit scholarly work and research in paper sessions, poster sessions, and panel discussions. All topical areas and methodologies of accounting, finance, and economics research are welcome. There is no submission fee.

Submissions for papers and poster sessions will be subject to blind peer review. Papers submitted by PhD students will be considered for the normal program. All other student research will be considered for the Student Symposium.

AARE will recognize the best paper award in each of the following topics:

- Financial accounting & reporting;
- International accounting;
- Management accounting;
- Auditing;
- Tax;
- Teaching, learning, & curriculum;
- Student research;
- Current topics and emerging issues in accounting.

An FBD Distinguished Paper will also be selected.

Papers:

Please submit two pdf files:

1. A blind version of the paper with no title page
2. Separate title page with the authors' names and affiliations

An author can submit a maximum of two papers. Submitted papers must comply with AARE's AI policy (*forthcoming*).

Posters:

Please submit a title page with a 250-word abstract. For poster submissions and related questions, reach out to Dr. Jason Powell at powellja@nsula.edu.

Panels:

If you have an idea for a panel discussion or want to moderate that panel, submit your proposed topic, panel members, along with a brief description of the topic (up to 300 words). AARE assist with finding panelists.
